Notes

Some points to assist with uniformity in these ministries:

1. Use the words “**THE BODY OF CHRIST**” as you give the host to the communicant, on the tongue or in the hand, it is their choice
2. For non-communicants simply say “**THE BLESSING OF CHRIST**”, placing your hand over their head. The blessing is then given through the Eucharist you are bearing in the ciborium.
3. The communicant **MUST** consume the host in front of the altar, if they do not please follow them discreetly and ask them to consume the host then.
4. If you are not able to make any of the above dates, can you please arrange cover with another Reader or Extra-ordinary Minister directly and modify the list on the Church notice board.
5. For Readers: The first reader will read the Welcome at the beginning of Mass, the First Reading and lead the Psalm (for non sung Masses). The second reader will read the Second Reading and the Acclamation (for non sung Masses, remembering the Alleluia part should always be sung). After the Second Reading, the Lectionary book remains in place on the lectern and is not removed to the lower shelf. The second reader will also read the Bidding Prayers.
