NOTES FOR READERS

Readers are proclaimers of God's Word.

Note that the Old Testament has a prophetic tone whereas the New Testament teaches the Values of Christ.

Your text will be on the lectern before Mass : check it if you wish.

Both readers should be at the Lectern as the Creed ends.

Project your voice by speaking directly into the microphone.

The second reader retires from the Lectern before the Priest and acolytes arrive there.

Anyone who aspires to be a reader may try it at a weekday Mass.

NOTES FOR EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS

Both species of Holy Communion are equal.

Therefore the Priest and the accompanying minister process through the Church side-by-side

After Holy Communion has been distributed, cleansing of vessels may begin.

One minister should purify, at the credence table.

The other minister may retire.
